- 3. Evidence of current attendance at a college, university, or trade school
- 4. A sound argument, about 150- 200 words, justifying why they should be awarded the scholarship

Scholarship Committee

A committee, selected by the executive of the association, will choose the scholarship recipient from among all the applicants.

The committee's decision is final.

Requirements of the scholarship Recipient

- 1. Attend the anniversary gala held in November at which time he/she will be awarded the scholarship.
- 2. Make a conscious effort to stay in touch with and support the activities of the association.
