Ottawa, July 01, 2024 – In the wake of the devasting impact of Hurricane Beryl on July 1, the St. Vincent and the Grenadines Association of Ottawa Inc. (SVGAO) is mobilizing a rapid-response relief effort. Our mission is to provide immediate and long-term assistance to affected communities and help them rebuild their lives.
